

NOOSA NORTH SHORE & NOOSA EVERGLADES

Boreen Point and Elanda Point are the gateway to the upper Noosa River, the Noosa Everglades and the Great Sandy National Park. Boreen Point is a small township on Queensland's largest natural saltwater lake, while Lake Cootharaba is a perfect setting for sailing, kayaking and spotting an array of native wildlife including kangaroos and birds.

Just across the Noosa River via the car ferry at Tewantin is Noosa North Shore – more than 80km of unspoilt open beaches, golden sands and forest wilderness. Popular for camping, fishing, beach horse-riding, surfing, 4 wheel driving and more (permits required), it's also the gateway to the Cooloola Great Walk through the Great Sandy National Park, and to World Heritage-listed K'gari – Fraser Island.

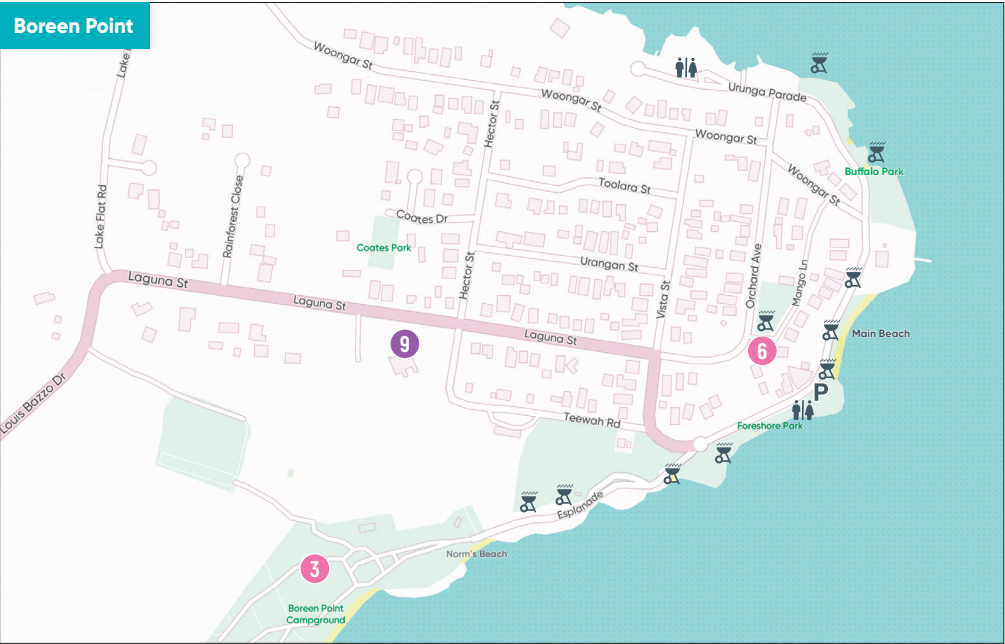
