Noosa is the traditional home of the Kabi Kabi people, whose land stretches roughly 100km south and 150km north of Noosa. Noosa is a unique destination – a multi-faceted gem. Awarded World Surfing Reserve status for its superb beaches and point breaks, Noosa is also a designated UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, which acknowledges the town's harmonious relationship between people and nature. The jewels of the Noosa area include a pristine river system that winds its way upstream to one of only two everglades systems on earth, hinterland villages that calm the soul, eclectic boutique shopping, gastronomy, world-class events, and a vibrant arts and culture scene making it a favourite destination for both relaxation and adventure.








SUNSHINE COAST AIRPORT - 30 MINUTES' DRIVE

A short drive from Noosa's golden shores, Sunshine Coast Airport welcomes direct flights from a number of Australian destinations including Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Canberra, Newcastle, Cairns and Auckland (from July 2022). With a new runway launched in 2020, the airport will attract more flights, more often from key domestic and international destinations. 






DONATE A TREE

WHALE WATCHING

Noosa is perfectly placed on the whale highway as 30,000+ humpback whales migrate up the Queensland coast and back to Antarctica between July and the end of October. Each year Noosa is blessed with incredible sightings of these amazing mammals as they head north to seek warmer waters.

There are many vantage points along Noosa's coastline as well as several experiences and tours where you can encounter the magical sightings of breaching whales as they frolic with their newly born calves.

Spot whales from the air via helicopter or skydive, jump on an adventure ride out past Noosa Main Beach for an up-close-and-personal experience or take a day trip from Noosa to join a whale watching tour in nearby Mooloolaba or in the Whale Watching Capital of Australia – Hervey Bay.



COASTAL VILLAGES

Wind your way along the stunning coast road, with epic sea and hinterland views, and discover the seaside villages from Noosa Heads to Sunshine Beach and Peregian Beach. Nature surrounds the area, with stretches of National Park dotted between towns, and quaint seaside villages filled with boutiques, cafés, and restaurants to explore.





HASTINGS STREET AND NOOSA HEADS

One of only a handful of Northfacing beaches in Australia, the
calm, sheltered waters of Noosa
Main Beach offer perfect learnto-surf waves. Bordering Noosa
Main Beach is the iconic Hastings
Street, with its eclectic offering
of chic boutiques, selling
international and local
labels, and a selection

labels, and a selection of world-class restaurants, cafés, bars, hole-in-thewall coffee nooks and gourmet ice cream shops.



NOOSAVILLE

With the Noosa River winding through its heart, Noosaville is a laidback holiday spot with gorgeous water views, shady trees and picnic spots along a grassy foreshore.

Restaurants, boutiques and cafés overlook the river with a lazy stroll to a great range of family-friendly holiday accommodation. Jump on the Noosa Ferry or visit the industrial area for craft breweries, distilleries, local design showrooms, a chocolate factory and popular organic markets.

THE NOOSA COASTAL WALK

One of the few National Park trails in Australia where you can follow the line of the coast all the way around the headland. This iconic 10.8km (return) coastal trail leads you to the southern end of Noosa National Park, with glorious vistas to neighbouring beaches including Sunshine Beach and Peregian Beach.



NOOSA EVERGLADES

This pristine wilderness area is known as the 'River of Mirrors' due to its amazingly reflective, pure waters, and is one of only two everglades systems on earth. This area of pristine waterways and wetlands is a photographer's dream, a bird watcher's paradise,

and a nature lover's perfect escape, and boasts an unrivalled ecosystem that is home to over 40 per cent of Australia's bird species. All of this is just a stone's throw from the heart of Noosa, and accessible by boat or kayak.



NOOSA JUNCTION

A hive of activity, the area has grown rapidly, spoiling visitors with funky bars, restaurants for every tastebud, bustling coffee shops, fashion boutiques, home designs, laneways with local art murals, night markets, and photo galleries. The J Noosa' is a venue attracting local and touring performers and film festivals.

HINTERLAND VILLAGES

NOOSA BIOSPHERE TRAILS

Explore one of the eight scenic hinterland trails, suitable for walking, biking, horse-riding or birdwatching – or climb a mountain for stunning views. The trail network is surrounded by charming villages, each offering something a little unique and special.







POMONA

Pomona is a gorgeous hinterland town filled with cafés, a country hotel, art galleries, and a cute weekly country market. If you're feeling super fit, climb the challenging 439m high Mt Cooroora, or see a silent movie at the Majestic Theatre, finishing with a stop at the Pomona Distilling Co.

8 DELIGHTS OF THE NOOSA FORESHORE



NOOSA'S NEIGHBOURS



RAINBOW BEACH


Join a guided 4WD tour and travel 60km via the Great Beach Drive from Noosa to the beachside town of Rainbow Beach. The town is a hidden treasure and offers breathtaking coastline, 72 shades of coloured sands on cliff faces and some of the best coastal views in Australia. The magnificent sunrises and sunsets at Carlo Sand Blow, a 15-hectare sand mass that is over 500,000 years old, is an unmissable experience. Marine and wildlife are abundant, including millions of soldier crabs, migrating whales (seasonal) and it is a breeding ground for the endangered Grey Nurse Sharks, which attracts divers from around the world.


SUNSHINE COAST The Sunshine Coast region is a nature enthusiast's delight. Blessed with over 100km of white sandy beaches, bordered by lush green hinterland and the volcanic peaks of the Glass House Mountains. You can be surfing in the morning and hiking waterfalls by lunchtime. The towns of Maleny and Montville are encased in rainforest, dotted throughout with B&Bs and hinterland escapes. Caloundra, Mooloolaba and Coolum each have their own unique personality offering surfing beaches, great restaurants, and lots of fun activities for all ages.

LADY ELLIOT ISLAND Flights to Lady Elliot Island depart daily from Hervey Bay Airport, about 3 hours' drive north of Noosa. Explore this underwater wonderland from the award-winning nature-based resort – perfect for a day tour or overnight stays. Snorkel (safe for beginners) or dive the southern-most point of the Great Barrier Reef and explore nature's seasonal migration including turtle nesting, giant manta rays, humpback whales and sea birds, as well as a year-round array of other marine life and unspoilt coral reef.

NOOSA ICONS

Every visit to Noosa requires at least a day exploring the town. Most people wish they could stay longer once they realise the breadth of offerings near and far, using Noosa as a base.

DAY 1







Morning

NOOSA NATIONAL PARK

Noosa National Park isn't just a stunning pocket of protected sub-tropical rainforest jutting out into the Pacific Ocean, but a natural playground filled with walking trails, surf breaks, and snoozing koalas. During a morning hike with one of Outdoor Adventure Australia's qualified guides, you'll learn about the native fauna and flora while soaking up the beauty of the bushland.

Afternoon

VILLAGE EXPLORING

Drive the coast road from Noosa to Peregian
Beach for stunning expansive views of the ocean.
Spot whales breaching (July – October), as
you cruise past the village towns of Sunshine,
Sunrise or Peregian Beach. Discover fantastic
restaurants, cafés and boutique shopping, with the
Sunshine Beach Surf Club a must visit. Peregian
Beach fortnightly Sunday markets are home to a
collection of locally made wares and treasures.

Evening

SUNSET CRUISING

Jump on the Noosa Ferry for a sunset cruise with a glass of bubbles in hand. This must-do Noosa experience delights with vibrant colours as the day turns to dusk. Pass millionaire mansions, stunning National Park and be in awe of the variety of birdlife. Disembark at one of the river jetties and walk to dinner to dine on delectable local produce.

MAJESTIC NOOSA EVERGLADES

Join an Everglades Eco Safari tour or a more energetic kayaking tour with Kanu Kapers to explore the wilderness of the Noosa Everglades. Cruise through the subtropical rainforest and unforgettable, reflective waterways. Learn about the local Kabi Kabi people and the magnificent variety of fauna and flora. Stay onsite in a glamping tent underneath the stars.

Noosa provides fun for all ages to create lasting memories. Cuddle a koala at Australia Zoo, ride the Mary Valley Rattler Steam Train, swim with the seals at Sea Life Sunshine Coast, follow the Gruffalo at The Ginger Factory, take a selfie with exotic birds at Maleny Botanic Gardens Bird World or board Aqua Duck and be your own sea captain.

WATERFRONT DINING

Perch on the top deck of the Noosa Boathouse Sunset Bar for one of Noosa's best sunset spots. After a drink or two, head downstairs to the award-winning bistro where seasonal produce shines. Dine on their famous 3-tiered seafood platter with absolute waterfront views. On a Friday, order takeaway fresh local fish and chips and listen to live music on the river foreshore.

THE ORIGINAL EUMUNDI MARKETS

No visit to Noosa is complete without a visit to Australia's premier artisan markets, the Original Eumundi Markets. Home to over 500 stalls where you will meet the bakers, sewers and growers - it is the perfect stop to pick up a unique Australian gift. Eumundi has been tagged 'Newmundi' – with an array of new restaurants, accommodation, breweries, distilleries and shops.

Afternoon

HINTERLAND TREATS

Explore Noosa's country towns, home to exquisite local produce at farm gates where you can pick strawberries, taste ginger and finish at a craft brewery or distillery. Climb Mt Cooroora in Pomona, sample gin at 20 20 Distillery in Cooroy, meet the locals at Noosa Hinterland Brewery in Cooran, before stopping in Kin Kin at the General Store for an ethical produce lunch or afternoon tea.

NOOSA JUNCTION

Expect to find funky bars, cafés and restaurants with chic fit-outs and creative menus. Cuisines here include Mexican, Spanish, Italian, Japanese and Australia's first gut health bar. Finish the night at a wine or cocktail bar, watch a movie, **EXTEND** listen to live music, or see a live show at The J Noosa.

SPA PAMPERING



Local produce sings here, with the likes of baked Noosa scallops with vadouvan butter and cauliflower. Ingredients are produced by the restaurant's Maravista Farm, grown using compost made from waste sourced from the restaurant, coffee grinds, farm green waste and local brewery grain.

NORTH SHORE ADVENTURE
